Your Personal Element

Your Personal Element or Day Master is the starting point of your Life Pillars Chart. It represents the Heavenly Stem related to your day of birth. Only by knowing your Day Master, can all the other factors of your chart be understood.

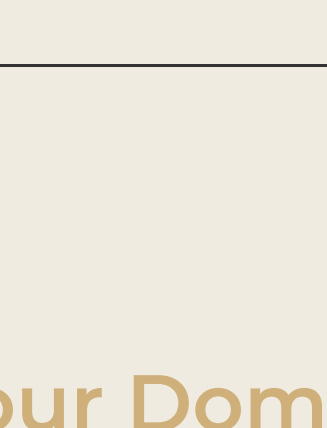

The PERSONAL ELEMENT should therefore be seen as the basis, the raw material that will be shaped by a group of forcers, namely the PROFILES, which reflect the cosmic conditions of your birth.

Your Natural Profile

The Entrepreneur is your Natural Profile.

Your Natural Profile is **THE ENTREPRENEUR**. This means that rather than counting on effort alone, your strong suit is analysing your surroundings and discover where the worthwhile **OPPORTUNITIES** lie.

Vision and sense of opportunity can be said to be two of your personality's basic instincts. Naturally, the degree to which they'll play a role and their impact (both positive or negative) on your life will depend on the set of forces that govern your personality.

If you feel you have a natural inclination towards adventure and action then it is more than likely that the more unstable side of Natural Profile will shine through. This might mean a life of ups and downs, in which the taste for risk can become a problem.

However, if this set of 'dominant forces' points towards stability and a more conservative or down-to-earth attitude, you can expect this Natural Profile to work as a natural remedy: it will avoid stagnation, favoring progress.

Rather than following a conventional path of progressively striving towards success - climbing a ladder, so to speak - it is your nature to constantly scan situations and moments, opting for the path with the greatest potential.

In short, this Natural Profile stimulates your ambition and what you demand of life.

Your Dominant Profile

THE ANALYSER

THE ANALYSER is a Dominant Profile of your personality. Therefore, the most important activity in your life is to **ANALYSE** data and information. (Should **THE ANALYSER** be your Natural Profile as well, then these predispositions are heavily accentuated)

THE ANALYSER is your personality's Dominant Profile.

Overall prudence and a need for safety are two vital features of this Profile. You probably need to feel safe and well-grounded before you move into action or venture into the unknown. Typically, those born under this Dominant Profile are experts in making their boundaries well known, a way of clearly defining their territory, creating a place they recognise and feel safe in.

Positive factors that derive from this need for safety are your propensity and capacity to study, analyse, obtain information, and further your knowledge. These abilities help you feel well informed and, therefore less vulnerable.

There's another important aspect of your Profile not related to ideas or information but to people. Unless other dominant profiles contradict this, you tend to be **people-oriented** rather than task-oriented.

In fact, this is one of your greatest strengths! Do note that this isn't merely a pragmatic way in which you feel it is beneficial to cultivate good relationships with others. Being under this Profile also means you feel most comfortable when "preparing for action". NOTE:

If your Natural Profile is THE ANALYSER as well, these predispositions will tend to be more accentuated. However, the positive side of this Profile tends to be more noticeable when combined with other Profiles like THE EXPERT, THE PERFORMER, THE OFFICER, or THE WARRIOR.

THE PHILOSOPHER

THE PHILOSOPHER is a Dominant Profile of your personality. (Should **THE PHILOSOPHER** be your Natural Profile as well, then these predispositions are heavily accentuated)

This Profile introduces a note of idealism or eccentricity to your person.

The crucial thing for your **THE PHILOSOPHER** Profile is the idea, concept, or vision and not so much the details (something "irrelevant"....) of its execution.

The human aspect is also important to you. It is no wonder that criteria of a spiritual and humanitarian nature appear among your main concerns.

Of course, other factors such as your Personal Element, your Natural Profile, or another Dominant Profile can change these characteristics or channel them to a specific type of activity.

Some celebrities with this Profile more visible are: **Leonardo DiCaprio, Brad Pitt, Bob Dylan, Steve Jobs, Jimi Hendrix, and Orson Welles**.

A curious example is that of business magnate, investor and philanthropist **Warren Buffett**, who has been linked to the American Philosophical Society. **THE PHILOSOPHER** Profile is, at the same time, his Natural Profile and a Dominant Profile. Here's an excellent example that original ideas can also be a path to success.

NOTE

These predispositions will be strongly accentuated if your Natural Profile is also THE PHILOSOPHER. But the beneficial side of your Profile tends to become more evident when there is, either as your Natural Profile or among your Dominant Profiles, any of the following: THE EXPERT, THE PERFORMER, THE OFFICER, or THE WARRIOR.

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
